This scholarship is in memory of Daisy Pabón, for her work and dedication to the Puerto Rican community, and is sponsored by Puerto Rican Civic Club, Inc. of San José (PRCC). Daisy passed away tragically in a car accident in 2001. Her wishes were to donate her organs to save other lives in case she departed early from this world. That shows the kind of person Daisy was.

She was also a delegate to the Western Region Puerto Rican Council (WRPRC) and very instrumental in developing a comprehensive media package, which for the first time announced Día de San Juan in the *Metro*, and in the front cover of *The Potpourri*. She also got major radio stations to sponsor the event. Daisy enjoyed working for the Puerto Rican community. She gave her best to the Día de San Juan festival, our Club, and the WRPRC.

Daisy was a professional and always strived for excellence. Her passion was advertising, but she also loved dancing salsa. Daisy cared for all her friends and was not shy when giving advice. She loved her daughter and newborn grandson with all her heart. Her smile was truly sincere, pleasant, and contagious, and will always be missed by those who had the pleasure of meeting, sharing, and working with her.

## Who Can Apply?

Students of Puerto Rican or Hispanic ancestry who are high school seniors, high school graduates, GED recipients, or college students pursuing an undergraduate or post-graduate education are encouraged to apply. To be considered students must have a 2.5 or higher GPA. Scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis with consideration given to academic record, extracurricular activities, work experience, community service, financial need, and an essay.

#### Award:

Scholarships in \$500.00 to \$1000 denomination each are awarded annually and are payable to student. Scholarships are awarded in August at a WRPRC event, or other event that has been designated beforehand. All recipients are strongly encouraged to attend this event which will be formally announced in your award letter if selected.

# Requirements:

- 1. The application must be written legibly or typed.
- 2. The application must be filled out completely.
- 3. The essay must be typed.
- 4. Must provide proof of current enrollment or letter of acceptance.
- 5. California students will be given priority.
- 6. Scholarship recipients will be notified by mail and honored at a local event in August.
- 7. Recipients must make every effort to attend the awards presentation event.
- 8. Recipients must agree to contribute 20 service hours to PRCC. A service agreement will be completed upon receipt of scholarship.

#### Deadline:

All applications must be postmarked no later than **May 22nd.** Supporting documents such as letter of recommendation, transcript, letter of admission, etc. must be received on or before **May 22nd**. An original completed application, transcript, proof of enrollment/acceptance and a 250-500 word essay must be included. The focus of the essay should be on your future academic, career goals, what being "Puerto Rican" means to you, and how you plan to contribute back to this community once you have achieved your goals.
